PHILIPPIANS 6

- 1. Why do we rejoice in the Lord?
- -Because we know that our Father will win over sin and death and Satan.
- 2. Can any difficulty that a true Christian has on earth ever take away our eternity with God in heaven?
 -No.
- 3. How are Christians the "circumcision"?
- -Because the Lord Jesus has cut out our old, sinful heart and given us a new heart.
- 4. Why does a Christian put no confidence in the flesh?
 -Because our flesh and the work of our flesh cannot save us.
- 5. After Paul met Christ, what was changed about his thinking?
- -After Paul met Christ, he understood that all that he had worked for was a loss compared to knowing Christ.
- 6. Why is it not possible to have a righteousness of our own that comes from the law?
- -No one can have a righteousness from the law because we have all broken the law.
- 7. What did Paul mean when he said that he wanted to know Christ?
- -Although Paul already knew the Lord Jesus, he wanted

to know Him as much as he could.

- 8. Can Christians become perfect on earth? -No.
- 9. Because we cannot become perfect on earth, should we stop trying to allow our God to perfect us?
 -No.
- -Our God is using every day in our lives to perfect us, and when we reach heaven, we will finally be perfect.
- 10, What is the "beauty" of remembering our past sins? -We remember what God has saved us from, and we thank God for saving us.
- 11. What is God's goal in the life of every Christian? -To make us like Christ.
- 12. At the end of our life, what will be our prize? -That we will be perfect without sin.

Let's read Philippians 3:15-16

- 15-All of us, then, who are mature should take such a view of things. And if on some point you think differently, that too God will make clear to you.
- 16-Only let us live up to what we have already attained.
- -To understand these verses, we must remember the teaching of the last lesson.

- -In the last lesson, God through Paul taught us that we are not yet perfect, but that we must press on, allowing God to continue to work in our lives.
- -When Christians think differently, we must read and study God's Word so that God will teach us..
- -What is important is that we stay on the spiritual path that our God has put us on.
- -It is God who has given us life on earth.
- -It is God who has caused us to believe in Him.
- -It is God who has put us on this spiritual path to perfection.
- -How do we continue on this spiritual path that God has put us on?
- -By continuing to read and study God's Word.

Let's read Philippians 3:17

17-Join together in following my example, brothers and sisters, and just as you have us as a model, keep your eyes on those who live as we do.

- -Do we Christians need encouragement?
- -Yes, very much.
- -When we are alone, the world, the flesh, and Satan can

hurt us very much.

- -When we are with other Christians who are strong in their faith in Christ, then we will be encouraged.
- -This is why the Word of God through Paul is encouraging the Philippians to follow his example.
- -This is why the Lord Jesus sent out the disciples two by two.
- -We must be careful, however, to follow the example of a person who does not exalt himself, but rather exalts Christ in his life.
- -Some Christians have followed the example of a false prophet or a pastor who has led them away from Christ and into many problems.
- -If we follow the example of another, what must we be sure of?
- -That the example of the one we are following is the same example of Christ.

Let's read Philippians 3:18-19

18-For, as I have often told you before and now tell you again even with tears, many live as enemies of the cross of Christ.

- 19-Their destiny is destruction, their god is their stomach, and their glory is in their shame. Their mind is set on earthly things.
- -Paul was crying because of the enemies of the cross of Christ.
- -Who are those who are enemies of the cross of Christ?
- -Their minds are on earthly things, and not eternal things.
- -Their god is their stomach.
- -Their destiny is destruction in the Lake of Eternal Fire.

Let's read Philippians 3:20-21

20-But our citizenship is in heaven. And we eagerly await a Savior from there, the Lord Jesus Christ,

21-who, by the power that enables him to bring everything under his control, will transform our lowly bodies so that they will be like his glorious body.

- -Our lives on earth are very temporary.
- -Our lives in heaven will be forever.
- -Although we may have a home on earth, where is our best home?
- -In heaven.
- -Although we live on the earth, we belong in heaven.

-Although our bodies are lowly, they will one day be glorious like the body of Christ after His resurrection.

Let's read Philippians 4:1

- 1-Therefore, my brothers and sisters, you whom I love and long for, my joy and crown, stand firm in the Lord in this way, dear friends!
- -The faith of the Christians in Philippi was a part of Paul's joy and crown.
- -Our only place which is firm or secure is in the Lord Jesus Christ.

Let's read Philippians 4:2-3

- 2-I plead with Euodia and I plead with Syntyche to be of the same mind in the Lord.
- 3-Yes, and I ask you, my true companion, help these women since they have contended at my side in the cause of the gospel, along with Clement and the rest of my co-workers, whose names are in the book of life.
- -Who are Euodia and Syntyche?
- -They were women in the church at Philippi who were fighting with one another.
- -Even though Euodia and Syntyche had helped Paul with beginning the church, they were now fighting and hurting the church.

- -Satan does not to need to hurt non Christians as they are still a part of his family.
- -Therefore, Satan tries to hurt Christians and break up the church.
- -For all Christians, nothing in heaven will separate us which means that nothing on earth should separate us.
- -From verse 3, who is Paul's "true companion"?
- -We do not know for sure.
- -Who are those whose names are in the book of life?
- -All Christians.

Let's read Philippians 4:4-5

- 4-Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice!
- 5-Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near.
- -Even when life is difficult, we can rejoice because God has given us eternal life.
- -How is the Lord near?
- -He is closer than breath itself.
- -Why is it important to understand that the Lord is near?
- -If we can understand and remember that the God who

has created the universe is near and with us, this will help us to never be afraid or worry.

- -The problem is that we forget this truth.
- -When we have a problem, we may forget that the Lord is near.
- -When others hurt us, we may forget that the Lord is near.
- -When we are sick, we may forget that the Lord is near.
- -If we can remember that our God is near to us and with us, our lives will be completely changed for the better.

Let's read Philippians 4:6-7

- 6-Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God.
- 7-And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.
- -We must talk to our God about everything.
- -Our God wants us to talk to Him about everything.
- -By being thankful to God, we have the peace of God which guards our hearts and minds.
