Testimonies Chronological Gospel 2023

1-January 18, 2023

I am Susan N., mother of twelve children, and five grandchildren. I am 62 years old now—a widow due to witchcraft. Here is how it went:

Birth and Life.

I was born to the late Jacob and Tercilla who are from strong witchcraft background. I stayed most of the time with my father and this made me see many people come to his shrine. In this shrine, we had different gods represented, i.e Wajumbe, the god of death and Wamugona, the fertility goddess.

People would visit my father's shrine and give sacrifices which to my surprise we would eat in the names of gods for they don't eat, see, talk, or even do anything . . . but we still had to believe—nothing more, nothing less.

In the year 1980, I lost my father, but was made to inherit the shrine as I was the only surviving child. I made a decree to serve [the gods] wherever I go, including marriage.

Marriage and death of Children

The worst thing—I continued serving and when I got married, I dedicated all my children to the gods of the land, as I was so much possessed with demons. I offered a lot of sacrifices—not only in the shrines, but also in the graves to please my ancestors and their gods.

To show my love to Walumbe, the god of death, I sacrificed my firstborn and that's how tragedy began in my family. Every year I would have to offer till at last my husband.

Every year I would go to their graves. I hated myself, serving the gods, offering my children, animals, community members as I did all the human offering in secret, but animals I did publicly.

Chronological story and Salvation.

It was last year when I was lost in thoughts and hoping to die that I met these good

grandsons of mine–Mnakenya and Mnyolee (referring to Felix and Joseph).

Though people feared my house, [Felix and Joseph] would come and share with me from small booklets about the holiness of God, His love, and I was so much touched when I came to learn how [demons] told our ancestors to slaughter their children. This touched me because it was not only my ancestors, but me as well. At this moment, I chased them out of my house to let me be judged and condemned.

As they started teaching in Busolwe this year with the next lessons, I called them to my house to share different dreams I have been getting and to pray with me.

It was a struggle but as I prayed a burden was lifted. I felt a great joy—my grandchildren are so happy that I am transformed. Every night they read to me these booklets as I have loved to listen to the stories, but I don't know how to read. Though I can listen to small English, they tell me the stories in Luganda.

Thanks to the Lord Jesus Christ for accepting to die for me, and teaching me that He don't need human sacrifice like my ancestors did. I am transformed child of God.

Thanks for my sons Mnakenya and Mnyolee for bringing me this good news with love and being patient with me everyday.

These booklets are good. Indeed, I lost my children, husband, and family but God has given me another family of love, peace, and joy. My prayer is to get these books "talking" so I can listen everyday by myself and share with people of my age.

2-January 18, 2023

An old man named Kentoi Ole Selelo woke up at 4 am to be at the venue on time so as not to miss anything. Despite his blindness, he tracked 10km just to come and hear the good news. After listening to our teachings this is what he had to say:

"I thought you people had come to take pictures so that you can go and get money on our behalf and leave us as we are, I thank God you are true messengers. You have brought us something better, not the Mzungu [white man's] religion, but the truth to save us. I may be blind, but I know God loves me. This is why he has sent you to me. God created everything good and I know I am very good in the eyes of God. Please give my son one book so that he will read it to me as we go home. Now I can hear from my own language. Greet those who sent the books to us. God bless you!"

3-January 20, 2023

Jane Achieng was born to parents who later divorced as the father was a Muslim and the mother a Christian.

"My family didn't know peace. My husband, Sheik Ibrahim was one of the reknown witch consultants in Bubalia," says Sister Tercilla (Jane's mother).

Since these teachings started, I learnt many things in the booklets. One thing is the story of people during Noah's time. Noah built the ark, and his neighbors didn't enter because of disobedience.

When my husband left me, due to my faith in Christ, my children choose to be with their father and I was left with one—Jane Achieng. In a period of two years, my daughter started behaviors I couldn't understand and then ran mad, ending up in the street.

Life became so challenging. My daughter was so violent and could not want anyone to approach near her. Her food she picked [out of the garbage dump]. As a loving mother, I kept on watching after her at a distance.

One Monday morning, I woke up, and Jane was no longer in her normal place. She came after five months with a pregnancy from unknown man.

I became so scared of her and the baby. I spoke to my neighbors who helped me tie her with ropes and bring her home. I was told to try out the [witch doctor] but I refused. This brought more rejection and mockery.

After giving birth, my daughter left home—never to be seen again, I was a mother and a grandmother. I would feed my grandchild with porridge and milk. Thankfully, she is now 3 years old.

While I was listening to the teachings, I learnt that all these is because of the devil

who doesn't wish us anything good. I shared with Felix and Joseph my problem and we prayed to God together.

It was on Thursday afternoon, while we were having open air crusade after sharing the chronological teaching in the church that from nowhere, the Lord brought my mad daughter to the crusade.

People prayed for her, and she gained normality. Thanks to God, I shared this with Felix and Joseph to go home, to take us home, and to pray with us.

The devil has lost the battle. Jesus has victory over my house, they assured me.

At night while I was asleep I heard a knock and was so hesitant to open, but I opened anyway. I could not believe the sight of my husband kneeling down asking me to forgive him. He said he has changed—that he dreamed about two young men going to pray with us in our family on 7th of January and the dream said he should come on Thursday, but due to fear, he came at night.

"I am no longer Sheik Ibrahim," he says. "I want a new name."

Through teaching, Ibrahim accepted the Lord Jesus Christ. He promised to bring the two children home.

What a reunion the Lord Jesus Christ brought through chronological teachings. Thanks for continuous support and prayer.

4-January 23, 2023

Sheikh Ibrahim shares later after the crusade, "In my life as a sheikh, all I have been knowing is I am sick. I need a doctor. The challenge—I have never been prepared to receive Jesus Christ. These booklets are so good. I have been reading and in one week I am filled with joy. My heart is open to the Lord and keep on teaching this message to the Muslim community."

5-January 23, 2023

Sister Sausa says, "I have never thought it's the devil telling me to disobey God. I listened to the devil. Like Noah, I have been a heavy drunkard, and have lived a bad life. Thanks to God, He still shares His love with me."

6-January 23, 2023

Pastor Peter says: "[My initial] theology made me think so wicked about the children of Israel. In lesson 29, I have learnt that it is our story. Like the children of Israel, we have disobeyed the Lord. May the Lord keep on teaching us simple biblical truths."

7-January 23, 2023

Pastor David had a thought and shared this with us: "Salvation didn't start with the Gospels. We have had a weak foundation, thereby bringing a very negative result. May the Lord bless you as you keep on teaching with humility."

8-January 23, 2023

"Being a witch is idol worship. It is worshiping Satan," says Susan who was formerly a witch.

9-January 27, 2023

My name is [name withheld], am a Borana living in [name withheld] village. Born and raised in a Muslim family. I have gone to madrassa [Islamic school] and have memorized the Quran. I grew up knowing that Christians are our enemies.

I joined a cattle rustling group where we raided villages and stole their cattle. The worst I remember is when we invaded a place in [name withheld], killed and burnt houses as we stole their cows. This has remained in my mind, guilt has tormented me, and have always wondered if God will ever forgive me.

Am married as per the Islamic laws and have children who go to madrassa, but my heart has always been that I don't want my boys to follow my background. I have been asking Allah [the Islamic word for "God"] to send me someone who could tell me more about the coming of ISSA [Christ] to judge us as stated in the Quran.

One day on my way to the market, I met some guys who were talking about Jesus. My spirit told me to ask them—what they were saying—and we began talking and thus how I met Pastor [name withheld] who was teaching them. I asked him if he could teach me the same and he gave me some books that I have been reading.

Since then, I thank God now that I know the truth, I have given my life to Christ and I know he has forgiven me. My family now is no longer Muslims. I don't want my boys to kill anyone. I believe I am born again as Christ died for me too. I want to belong to the good tribe of God. I was in darkness but I have seen the light.

If I am to be killed for giving my life to Christ so be it. I will be happy in heaven with God and not in hell with seven virgins garnishing my teeth [from a Muslim belief]. Please keep praying for me as I plan to move to [another village] with my family.

God bless you. Inshallah we shall meet.

10-February 11, 2023

My name is Neema Namulembe, born in Butaleja District, west Budama. My Father is a strong Muslim. He was an Imam of one of the mosques which is now sort of a shrine. My mother Beatrice was a Christian woman when she got married to my dad, but since women have no say and can't follow their own belief, she was forced to be a Muslim.

When I was born in 1990, my parents started having small disputes as my father would change women like daily clothes and not to be questioned as it is allowed in Islamic culture. When Daddy would be asked, he would say, "As many as my right hand possesses."

At the age of 15 years, I was forced into female genital mutilation and later, by my father, married to an old sheik of around 54 years as the fifth wife, thus terminating my education. In African culture, especially Muslims and unlearned men, wealth (dowry) is more important than a girl's life.

In this my new family, the other wives mistreated me. I had no peace and thus resorted to addiction. I would go out and smoke. I hated my life and swore that I will never return to either back home or even to my parent's home until both my unloving father and husband were dead.

In the year 2012, I was diagnosed of liver disease and since then I started battling with this sickness. I have passed through many challenges, but above all addiction.

Being a drug addict, there is no separation with sexual sin, and men would use me, sometimes in exchange for opium, alcohol, marijuana, and others.

In December of the year 2019, when my father died, I returned back home to stay with my sick mother due to stress she was having. Of course, I was still in heavy addiction, and sometimes would cause more harm to her than good.

In 2021, I would go with my mother to the garden, but one day I was drunk, undressed, and ran about mad, shouting words I didn't even understand.

Thanks to our loving God, people from the church started visiting me. But, they condemned me for being a drug addict, and told me about hell. When I looked at my own life, I saw more hell than what they would tell me. This only resulted in telling them a slogan of drunkards in our area: "WE ARE READY FOR HELL, WE ARE A BIG TEAM UNITED. WHEN WE GO TO HELL WE SHALL URINATE AND KILL THE FIRE!!"

It was one day last year that while in my stressful mood, looking forward to help and thinking of death, with a bottle in my hand, I approached the compound of Joseph and Felix.

These two young men were so concerned and showed me love. They would not condemn me for taking alcohol while they spoke to me about their loving and holy God. At this point, I chose to come everyday and listen to them, but my intentions were not positive. I wanted someone to be my friend, a husband I could have sex with.

They seemed to have studied me and everyday they would speak about the truth: Creation, Adam was in charge, and then, the fall of man. How one fruit, one bite, and then, all men sinned. This touched me so much.

One day as I came, they shared with me from a story of one man called Noah and his wine—when he got drunk. At that point, I grew mad at them and left without a goodbye.

Coming back, I said, "Never ever talk of alcohol. This has been my peace." They apologized and asked me a question: "Would you love to curse your generation, parents, and neighbors because of drunkardness?"

This pricked my heart so much. However, they kept on reassuring me of the love of a holy God, who slaughtered an animal for Adam and Eve, who told the children of Israel to obey while in the land of Egypt, who made Moses grow in the land of Egypt in the palace to later save His people. They shared about a lot of things, but when it came to a story of the Son, they reminded me of the seed of the woman spoken and asked me, "What do you think of this?" At this point, I left all drugs, but I didn't know how. However, I never made any decision.

On the evening of 21st January, after thinking for a long time, I called them and told them I would love to meet them. After reading the booklets they gave me and recalling on the teachings they have been having with me, I just cried so much. I chose to ask them what should I do, for I want this loving God. They led me to prayers.

I confessed my agendas to them, and asked them to pray with me so I could forgive my father and all that he did to me, to forgive everyone and to start living a holy and happy life.

Since then, they told me that I am forgiven, and reassured me that my God is more loving that my earthly father. He is good and I can reach him all the time.

I am so happy that I went from a drug addict to a God addict. Every time is prayer time, and encouraging other people never to give up on God. I share the Bible stories in this booklets.

11-February 24, 2023

My name is Fatima. I am saved and have given my life to Jesus Christ. I am the third wife to a Muslim man who I will not say his name. I got married to him as a ransom from my father who had his debt and when he was unable to pay, I was given out for marriage as a substitute.

I was only fourteen years old when this happened. It took me years to come to terms with this marriage. I was seen as a nobody by my cowives and I was ridiculed everyday. As a young girl, I was victimized by my husband as I had no say in his life. My life has been full of pains, and I hated my father so much that he could compare me with kes. 1000/= (\$7.88).

The worst came when I got pregnant and bore a baby girl. This didn't go well as

my husband wanted a baby boy. I was denied food for days so that I could die of hunger. I remember calling Allah several times, but nothing changed.

One day I went to the market to beg for food, and on my way I heard Christians singing. I decided to get and try their God. I didn't bother if my husband would see me and kill me.

After the singing, there were teachings by a pastor they had invited from Marsabit. He read stories of how we were all sinners and that God sent His son to take our place. This struck me as I was also given out to replace money.

My hunger and pains went away for some time. I wanted to know more, as he continued about how He was nailed on the cross, how He was spitted on, how they tore His clothes. This made me cry as this was what I was going through.

The Pastor shared how Jesus came to his own and they rejected him, and I remembered how my dad chased me out of home one day. I came to tell him what I was going through. That day I left the church wondering where Jesus was so I could talk to him.

Two days later, I went to the church and I gained courage to ask the pastor if I could talk to the Jesus he was teaching about the other day. The pastor looked at me. Maybe he thought I was mad, but I told him I wanted to talk to Jesus.

The pastor took me to the office where he shared more with me about Jesus. He asked me if I knew how to read and he gave me some books that I started to read in Borana. I would hide them under my mattress and through the whole night I read them

Jesus talked to me through the books. I met Pastor Moffat after three months and he led me to give my life to Jesus. Since then, my life has been peaceful. I have forgiven my husband and my dad. I gained courage and told my husband I am a Christian. I was shocked that he did not react badly but he told me to follow what I thought was right.

I give God all the glory that I met a family that values me in the church. Thank you for the books Pastor Moffat gave me. I read the stories to my kids every day as now I can't hide them. My husband came one day and found me reading them and he has allowed us to read them openly.

My husband married two other wives. We are now five and so he has no time to follow up what we are doing. I thank God for my co-wife who has joined me and now we go to church together Pray for us that we will follow Christ.

12-March 8, 2023

From the leader of the PAG church denomination in Kenya:

"We are so grateful for the truth that has been revealed to the church and the body of Christ in East Africa. Chronological lessons have changed our church. Our pastors' perspectives about the Gospel have changed and many souls have given their lives to Christ. From the testimonies we receive, families have been strengthened, reconciled, and restored to the truth. The truth has set many free from bondage.

It's because of this that we requested 4,500 copies of lessons 69-80. These books are going to be multiplied by 20 as we have asked each pastor to make 20 copies each more for their churches. This will in turn be 900,000 books that will reach out to our churches. We value these resources and we hope to have these teachings repeated again from lesson 1 next year. As usual the church already has the KES 900,000/shillings to pay for the down payment as agreed and we hope to have these ready soonest."

13-March 14, 2023

Dear Friends, I give God all the glory that the food arrived safely.

Pastor David (a Maasai pastor) came for the food himself after there was fighting in the village that couldn't allow me to go. I thank God for the truck that we had paid refunded the money and we had to pay for the car that David came with.

What God's purpose for this journey am yet to understand. Pastor David was given a police man armed with a rifle to escort him. Though not a Christian yet, he was willing to know this God that provided food for the village. This is the only time the village has received any help from anybody or organization. Even the Kenyan government has never sent any food to the village. Our generous gesture has turned the village to want to know who this Enkai (God) who sent

them food is (The earthly government could not provide but the heavenly government did provide). I believe God has a plan for all that is happening. All Glory belong to Him.

Pastor David sent greetings to all who gave and so grateful to God for providing for them. Mungu awabariki saana.

14-March 20, 2023

From Bithian:

"When I began reaching out to street girls I didn't know that God had a greater vision for me. I despised myself. Little did I know that God had chosen me to serve Him. Every time I enter a school at the gate my heart skips a bit, but as I enter a voice speaks to me, 'Bithian you will do it' and yes I have done it."

God has opened up more schools for the teaching and more girls are giving their lives to Christ. The need for a Savior in our schools to build a generation that will worship the true God and live a Christ like life is my desire."

So far we have distributed 500 books of lessons 1-10 to five schools with each school having 100 books. [We also have] 500 books of lessons 11-20 in the seven schools that we started with." (She is working in twelve schools.

Please pray for teachers who are embracing the lessons that God will use them even more. Pray for the Girls who have given their lives to Christ that God will sustain them in His Salvation. As more schools come on board I need more books. Please pray for provision for another 300 books for lesson 1-10 and 300 books lessons 11-20. Pray that as I share with the students God will keep me humble and focused to His calling.

A Testimony from One of the Girls:

"I am the third born in our family. My elder sister got married at the age of 14 years. This was due to the frustrations that we were going through.

Our father was a brutal man. He could come home drunk and beat anyone without any mistakes. My mother decided to go back to her parental home and they divorced. We have been living with our uncles since then.

My mum has done all sorts of jobs to ensure we get food and school fees for me and my younger siblings. I have been studying, yes, but I have never had peace of mind and heart, as I kept asking myself if our lives will ever get better.

I have been so bitter with my father who married another woman and has never bothered about us. I have kept bitterness in me that I do not even talk nor greet him when we meet.

When I started to study these books, I began to see a different perspective of life. I knew I needed a Savior to change my life and change my attitude towards my father. The more I read the books, the more I know I need Christ in my life.

I want to be a good girl, I want to be of the good tribe of God. I want to have life with Jesus and I know he will be there for me through my education. After I knew that God has forgiven me, I have forgiven my Dad too and I hope to meet him soon as I get the chance. Just pray for me to be strong in Christ." Naomi.

15-March 23, 2023

Mama Jane

Before meeting the chronological teaching team, I didn't know anything except working as a sex worker after being separated from my husband as I couldn't watch sexual abuse and even rape from a man I expected would be loving me.

The church and pastors kept on abusing me, and looking at me as the worst sinner in the whole world who even Jesus Christ couldn't save through His death on the Cross.

When I met these brothers, they shared with me the booklets and for the first time I found love in men proclaiming God's Word to me.

The hardest point to me is to stop looking for men to be my hope, though I believed in Christ, I was still not ready to trust Him with my finances and two children, Mary and Jane.

One day, while reading the booklets and seeing how the Lord provided an animal skin for Adam and Eve's nakedness to be covered, this touched me that God could also cover my sin and forgive me.

After two months of struggling to let off go of addiction, I learnt in me that I don't have to struggle alone because I can't save myself just like Adam and Eve couldn't save themselves, and being born out of Garden of Eden I am a sinner and needing a Savior.

I would thank God He provided me work to work as a chef in a restaurant, and through this I am able to pay my rent, take care of my children and schools fees.

I encourage someone over there, that God is so loving and He can still remove you from any addiction be it masturbating, sexual addiction, drug abuse, unforgiveness. And all these.

"Indeed what God cannot do [does not] exist."

16-March 30, 2023

Mzee Peter Lebom, from Kajiado is one of them that has received the light. He is the first person I met on my first trip to Maasai land...

"I have been herding all my life. I have believed in having more and more cows that you are blessed and in good books with God. I believed that God loves me thus why he had given me cows and I would go to heaven for taking care of God's animals.

I didn't know I need a savior and not cows to enter heaven. Yes, I can read that from the books you gave me that Only Jesus is our true Savior."

17-April 3, 2023

From the Meru tribe, Pastor Nicholus Murungi from Isiolo had this to say. "I am 65 years old and have been in ministry for over 26 years now. I went to a Bible school and most of what I was taught there has never been helpful to me in my service. All I was told is to teach people the Word without knowing the foundation of the Word. Today, I am leaving this [teaching] with the knowledge of how I should present the Gospel to the people. Our bench mark is God. God's standard that leads to Christ and our Helper Holy Spirit. I have seen these books with some of my Borana friends, but I didn't know how sweet they are. Simple but with a profound foundation of our salvation. I need these books for my Church."

18-April 3, 2023

Pastor Elias Mutei from Karatina "These teachings have come at the right time with the current confusion in churches and where pastors are selfish looking for money. It's time we need to get back to the truth. Only God is good and we all have fallen short of His Glory. We need to help our churches know we are sinners, even as we are as pastors. We have failed the standard of God. We preach heresy and not the true foundation of our faith. This is the foundation of our faith. The true need of salvation for a Savior who can bring us back to the Lord. Let's teach these [booklets] to our People."

19-April 3, 2023

Pastor Nancy Wamboi from Thika: "In college, I learned how to critique and support already written documents that had no foundation like what we are learning today. Many times we make altar calls, and we see hands raised. We rejoice that souls have been won, but have we taught them the truth? I feel we have to repent as pastors for we have not done what is required of us. Let's not waste time now that we have been enlightened. Let's hit the road running and share this gold to our congregation. Christ loves us. This is why we have these great teachings."

20-April 11, 2023

Here is the note from South Sudan:

Our brother in Christ Rev Wycliffe, we thank God for you always. You have helped enlighten our people from darkness. As you know it is the Ramadan period and many people here are fasting, hoping to get help from Allah who they don't know or have a personal relationship with.

To us it has been a great time to share with our friends who can read Arabic Arabic alphabets. It is our Joy when we share the truth with others and as you always remind us, it is God who stirs their hearts to salvation.

We had a great [teaching] in AL Kur where we had 20 Muslims who attended all through and we gave them the booklets and they kept asking questions which we tried to answer as the Holy Spirit led. We believe we planted the truth in them.

We thank God for the pastors in Talodi who are sharing this with The SPLM ravels who want to know more about Christ. We have had several who have given their lives to Christ from this bush area. One of the sweet things about the books is that it speaks to people in their language. In Nuer we have had cry after knowing the truth and going back to their families again and this gives glory to God.

Brother we will be in Nairobi on 24th April, Please, we don't want to stop this move. Kindly help us carry some more lessons back home.

We would greatly appreciate it if we can get 500 of Nuer lessons 43-68 and 500 of Arabic Arabic lessons 43-68. We will come with empty suitcases to stock in. Once again, thank you so much for being part of the Lord's work in Nuba mountains. God bless you.

21-April 17, 2023

Being a Dinka Madang--It's true we love prestige and pride. My name is Guwo. I came from South Sudan, due to the Dinka- Nuer tribal/ political war. I was a soldier, and my aim as a captain was to see the Nuer tribe swept flat and none remaining.

This war did cost me a lot including separation from my own family, and later, I learned of the death of my children. The worst enemy of life is war, and as long as we live, we should always learn that life is war. It's so much war that nothing can stop except someone who has Jesus.

In early 2000, I ran into Uganda just for the sake of my peace and chose to be a refugee in Adjumani. However, the devil could still use me more and more. I started speaking to myself and became very hostile.

In 2011, I said enough to [refugee] camp life and kept on walking until I was welcomed in Oruwamuge in a Abim District. I had developed a serious cough and I would sometimes cough blood, a very dry and painful cough. Because I needed freedom, I chose to start [to work in building construction] because I had learnt that, and this gave me a little income, but with difficulties due to frequent ailments

All this time, no one could come and share with me God's love, and I was ready to die. I hated my life. Others said that I had TB, and they would not associate with me. When this team came to Abim, they gave out booklets written in English. Since I was doing nothing much, I would be in the house for a long time, reading [the booklets] and telling God, "If only I could find my family to bury me."

[The team] kept on praying with me and I am saying God answers prayers. The cough is gone and two weeks ago, my wife traced me and found me. We're happily re-united, and ready to go back to South Sudan, and serve as peace ambassadors between my tribe and the Nuer.

I am old now at 56 years but the Lord is my strength. Thanks so much for the chronological teachings. What a blessing.

This place is full of blood of warriors. Some have been burnt alive. Some have been cut into small pieces just like firewood. My God, I am sorry I feel so much touched and a fresh breath in me to see what the Lord is doing, through crusades and teachings.

Chronological teaching is a book to be embraced, self learnt, and never dream of keeping this booklet and knowledge therein to yourself. To the ministry supporters, may the Lord bless you, may you never lack and always thanks for opening your arm to the unengaged land of Karamoja.

27-May 12, 2023

I want to thank God for this testimony. I share to the Glory of God.

"Formerly I was a persecutor of the church. I was a Muslim and also a witch for my religion to prosper. I used charms for everything to go on well.

One day while having debates in Iganga district (Uganda), a prominent debate ground, I was called to the podium and instead of greeting 'Asaalam Alaikum' (a Muslim greeting), I greeted, 'Praise Jesus.' This was the beginning of my persecution.

With great anger, they removed me up and took me inside the house. It was such a confusing moment for me. Immediately, I heard a voice calling me, 'Sulait! Sulait! Be strong. It's not all about you, but about me. Be strong and have no fear. I have chosen you and you are therefore mine!'

My people came in plus other Muslims, and started beating me up, called me all sort of names, and accused me of Shirk, the most unforgivable sin in Islam. My mother was asked what to be done to me and then she said anything as long as I remain a Muslim, even if it means death, torture, or even imprisonment.

My father and mother agreed that I should be put to prison and therefore my uncles and the clans plus other Muslims took me in. For the next three months, my life was hell. I suffered under persecution—what the police could do to me was horrible.

They were Muslim policemen and well paid to torture me. They did their work. For the first two weeks, they burnt my hands with hot water and 50 strokes with a cane every day. This destroyed my fingers, and I can no longer do hard labor.

One day, something horrible happened. They came to inquire whether I have changed and ready to accept Islamic religion again, which I told them, "No!" At this moment, they mixed a glass of water with poison and another one without poison, and brought it to me so that I can choose one to drink.

If [I would drink] the one of poison, it means Jesus has no power and I will definitely die. Immediately, when I stretched out my hands, the cup with poison fell down and I was surprised. Brethren, God is faithful and will always rescue his people. What He cannot do does not exist. He helped me.

This was not enough. They kept on making me suffer. What can I say, but God was on my side. My family refused to accept me, and I was rotting in prison. My mother rejected me and many times told me that I'm a reject.

In prison, God transformed me, but I still [liked?] a lot. Fear was my bread. I was looked down upon, but one day a policeman came in and inquired why I have been there for three months. Is it true that I was wasting money on ladies as my file was indicating? I replied boldly, 'No!' I have been a Christian and that is my crime I told him.

At this moment, the Lord was reminding me of the things I have been doing [in my previous life] like killing people, My previous life was the life of drinking blood and going underwater. I couldn't eat any food. I grew so thin. Witchcraft, all the blood I was drinking, and all the medicine I was using could not save me.

To this day, I have marks on my hands—two of these. One from the satanic shrine and another one from the beatings and torture in the prison.

I have moved so many places to find a solution, but no solution was found for me until one day I decided to attend the chronological Bible teaching while in Iganga. It was so touching to understand that the devil had stolen me and was busy taking me to hell. Our God is a faithful God. He doesn't forsake his own.

While teaching was going on, I felt the power of the Holy Spirit and I fell down. My heart was broken. My ego was gone. There is nobody like Jesus. He transforms lives and gives hope to the hopeless.

Today I live a life in Christ thanks to the chronological teaching. Thanks to Jesus, He has changed me. He still ministering to me.

Immediately, I no longer wanted my name, I requested my name to be changed, and after prayers, I was given the name Joseph. I have a new name, my sins are forgiven, and I am going to heaven by being a child of God. I am loved by God. With God everything is possible and I love always that.

What God cannot do does not exist. What God cannot change is never there. What God cannot heal has never been. Who God cannot use is not there.

Glory to God in the highest. From a child of the devil to a child of God. From Sulait to Joseph."

28-May 15, 2023

"I believed in a traditional god called Jehovah Wanyonyi. I got married to a man in Kitale who took me to this church. We have served in this church until my husband died.

The death of my husband opened a lot of questions in my heart. In his sickness. we had gone to our pastor for prayers. All he told us is that our ancestors were angry with us and that we have to sacrifice. We gave first a goat, then a sheep, and finally a cow, but my husband died. During his burial, the shameful pastor again claimed that the death of my husband was the anger of the ancestors and that I needed to now sacrifice our son. This broke my heart. I couldn't lose a husband and a son at the same time. NO!

Before I could make any decision, my elder son was attacked by unknown people and almost killed. I decided to look for another way. I visited Malakisi ADC church. I explained my problem to the pastor and he asked me to attend the teaching that will help me know the truth.

I have been attending the church teachings every Sunday and now I understand God can not allow us to sacrifice our own as he already has given a sacrifice—His son for us. If God sacrificed a lamb for Adam and Eve, He can do the same for us. God sacrificed a lamb instead of Isaac.

My son will not die. He is healed and now attends the teachings with me. God heard the cries of the Israelites in darkness in Egypt. It is my prayer that God will hear the cries of those who are lost in Jehovah Wanyonyi's church and send these books to them too. I was lost, but these books have saved me and my son from human sacrifices that don't save us. I now know the truth."

29-May 17, 2023

From Fiona Rahedi, a woman pastor in Uganda who is checking the Luganda

translation of the chronological teaching:

"I love reading books, and in my service, I have also read the Bible. When I first saw the booklets with brother Wycliffe, I felt they were for primary school and as a former teacher, W wanted to do the checking for the students.

31-May 23, 2023

"I am Mary Mwende born in Kitui, Kenya. I am a young lady of 22 years old. I was raised by a single parent. Though my father is alive, I have never met him.

I have been fellowshipping with Full Gospel Church in Magongo, Mombasa County, Kenya. Though I went to church, the trauma that I suffered with my mom was eating me slowly by slowly. I asked myself so many questions: "God, why me!" "What did I do to be treated like this?"

In school, due to depression, I saw my life as hell. In all my books, I would write two words: HELL and DEPRESSION. They are real.

My life has been so loathsome and sad to me. Many times I have thought of committing suicide, but I did not know how best to do it. Under stress and insulted from all sides, I started drinking and sleeping with men. Last month, after missing my period, I tested myself and found out that I am pregnant.

I did not want to think that I needed this life again. I do not even know the man who made me pregnant. The man that I thought was the one also rejected me.

When a trucker was moving to Uganda, I lied to him, telling him that I lost a friend in Uganda. He carried me to Uganda. The place was unknown to me because it was my first time.

I sat all by myself on the roadside, thinking of the last breath I would take before throwing myself under a passing vehicle so that I could die.

While thinking of this, a young man came to my side. His first words caused me to break out crying. He said, 'Young girl, you are loved so much! God loves you, and He is willing to change you if that's what you want.'

I started weeping and at that moment, he held me in his arms, tears rolling down. I have never ever been hugged by anyone. It was a dream. His name was Felix Bright.

He invited me to a friend's house to stay and he would check on me almost every day by phone or during the time we would study the Bible.

These booklets have given me hope. It's true. The enemy, the devil and all of his

demons want me dead and all other people dead. My life is changed. I feel a sense of belonging. I no longer think of abortion or suicide. I am loved.

I say depression is real, but love is even more real.

Being part of the family of God, I am forgiven, loved, and am walking a new walk. Pray with me that I'll get back to school and finish my courses. Thanks for the chronological teaching. Mary,"

32-June 2, 2023

In Nakalama, a new believer, David Waigolo who lives in Uganda, shares his joy:

Being part of the chronological teaching, I have learnt the great faithfulness of a great God.

Deception has been used as a tool to destroy God's people. As I was previously working for the government of Uganda, there were secrets I knew. Many of the government leaders go to witchcraft for protection and power.

As a captain of the troops, I was very much a part of the fighting. I have seen many wars like the one fought by the so called Kony of northern Uganda. When it comes to fighting, the devil doesn't want any good thing with God's people.

Many things I did to protect myself from dying in the sorties out in the bush. I have eaten the flesh of people who were killed in the battles, raping many women and even young girls. I deserved death. I have often fallen sick and I was just waiting for my death. Cigarettes have take over my life, and my internal organs are destroyed.

One day, while I was in a hospital bed, I believe that God gave me a dream. I saw people dying with guns, and I also saw a young man coming to me in the hospital bed, sharing with me the news about Jesus. Although I never wanted to hear about Him, He immediately showed me a cross. I saw His bleeding hands and He was calling me to Himself.

While this young man was still talking to me, he told me what the devil does: 'Satan is a liar. He hates all people. He hates God, and now He wants all people

go to hell.'

I wept while in the dream, and the next day, a young man came to the hospital and shared the very message in the dream through some booklets. He gave me a copy of all the booklets, prayed with me, and told me of the love of God.

After one week I was discharged, and David came to check on me. Thanks for the chronological team and the entire church for allowing a man who knew nothing except death, hatred and jealousy to become a child of God.

From Mama Raphael in Uganda:

"My marriage was been trouble. Even though I was born again, my new character did not show anything of the sort to my husband. My marriage was breaking up in front of my own eyes. My husband became a drunkard, and he would come home very late.

34-June 5, 2023

Testimony of Pastor Jérémie Kankisingi from Bukavu, Congo:

"I thank the Lord for the significant progress in the activities of the members of my community in relation to the first distribution of the chronological study booklets. Encouraging testimonies are beginning to reach us from just about everywhere we have sent booklets.

The children's ministry is also progressing well. The importance of these teachings contained in the booklets as well as the interest shown by the children in reading the booklets has inspired us to consider incorporating these teachings into their religion class.

Indeed, most of the children come from villages and families with little faith. It is, therefore, necessary to lead them to the way of the Lord. As the Bible says in Proverbs 22.6 "Instruct a child in the way he should go; and when he grows up or old, he will not turn away from it."

Currently we have approximately 20,000 students in our schools and more than 30,000 faithful in our churches across the country. 35-June 5, 2023

Testimony from Bunyakiri, Congo:

"The history of my life here on earth. Before I believed in the Lord Jesus Christ, I was bad for everything. When I was 15 years old, I decided to be a rebel soldier.

I entered the forest to join bandits for torturing people and looting their property. I did not see any good in anyone.

On May 2, 2023, I was in the mood for a walk. I met one of God's servants, pastor Samuel Enakasheshea. I thought of arresting him, but then he asked me where I was going. I replied that I was on a walk.

It was a sign from God and I felt a fire in my heart. Pastor Kasha gave me a book that had lessons 1-10. I returned to the place where I was staying, and I continued to read the book. I came to a sentence that said that God's message is very important. That night I did not sleep, and I continued to study God's Word which spoke of my sins.

We say thank you to the author of these books, and may God give him strength for a great work. He has the Word of God in these books.

The benefits we found in these books.

We have found many people who have come to believe in the Word of God here in Bunyakiri by teaching these books. People have been saved and have left their bad ways. It has brought changes to their foundation in both their physical and spiritual lives. Many of them are now in God's family.

37-June 5, 2023

Translated from French:

"My life was undesirable here on earth. I was baptized by Catholic priests, and started drinking alcohol right at my baptism party. From that time, my whole life was changed. Any money that I had, I spent on beer. Sometimes. I never made it home, spending the nights, in bars, club, in the street, and even sleeping in the gutters.

My life was so difficult that I couldn't even manage to buy clothes, wanting to steal from others. I started taking drugs like my friends on the street. Marijuana and alcohol were my usual food. I even forgot my family and my parents did not even know me as their child.

At the age of twenty, I had no idea what I was doing in life. I knew not my family. I walked around with several wounds on my body, not even knowing where they came from because of drugs.

One day, a man met me on the street, and started talking to me about stories from the Bible. I did not want to listen, as I was deeply disappointed with life. He insisted, however, and I asked him to come another day, believing that he would not come back.

He left a book with me, and I read it that night. It talked about the history of the Israelites and the love of God towards his people. While reading, I started to cry.

The next day, the man came back and started talking to me about the love of God and the forgiveness of sin that is in his son Jesus Christ. I asked him if I could also be forgiven by this God and he replied that God loves me.

I was convinced that my life was going to change, even in spite my sins, and I decided to give myself to Christ. Now, my whole life has changed and I am already a child of God as his servant told me.

My joy is immense because I already belong to the good tribe of God. I thank God for his servant David and the books he gave me. I cherish them much."

38-June 5, 2023

From Wycliffe visiting the work among the Maasai:

"On my visit, I met with different pastors from different denominations who are using the booklets. They all have praises to God for these booklets.

One of the pastors said this: 'Knowing God is the beginning of true life. God is the creator and so He has the manual of our life, No one can tell us how to live except for God. It is through the Bible that God speaks. These books speak to us

and help us hear what God says. Through them, we also know who God is and how he wants us to live. We now have the foundation of our salvation.'

I encouraged the pastors to teach themselves the books before they share them with others. This will impact their lives also."

39-June 5, 2023

From Wycliffe visiting the work in the north of Kenya:

"From Narok, I went to Garissa where I met with Pastor Moffat who works among the Boranas. Whatever God has started, He will accomplish, Moffat has gone to villages that have no churches and he has been teaching people in the bush.

Like the Maasai, the Boranas are pastoralists and they move searching for pasture for their animals. Pastor Moffat is going on well. So far, he has taught several Muslim families who have given their lives to Christ as well as invitations from churches to teach them the chronological lessons. He is planning to cross the border into Somalia in pursuit of the Boranas who live there in the border towns.

40-June 7, 2023

From a school girl in Kapsobet, Kenya:

"My name is Mary Vulimu. I am in Form Three West. I came to this school two years ago. I have never had peace with my teachers as I have been struggling with my reading. I didn't understand any book the teachers gave me to read

Last year we began to study these booklets. At first, I thought it would be just the same as the others, but "No," this has been the turning point of my life. God has used these books:

First, to help me know I have a Savior and that my life needs Him. Secondly, after reading the simple English used in the books, I began to understand what I was reading. I applied the same reading in other subjects and now I understand what I read!

My grades have improved and now I am at peace with both my teachers and my

parents. I now also know God and I have given my life to Him.

41-June 7, 2023

This is a testimony from a Borana in northern Kenya:

"I (name withheld).got married to a very beautiful woman. God blessed us with three children. I would go out to take care of our cows, and every time I came home I would find my wife unhappy. I wanted to know why and everyone I asked did not know the reason. I kept on like this for months and this started to stress me. I was afraid for the lives of my children

I took time off and decided that I would not go back out with the animals until I learned the truth. I learned that my wife had been fed with stories that I was cheating on her, that I had married another wife, and that I was spending my days with another woman—that I was lying to her.

I confronted my wife about it and she told me that this is what other people had told her. This is why she had come to hate me.

As a Muslim, we are allowed to marry many wives, but I had vowed to stay with my one wife. This really broke my heart that my wife would believe these lies.

Days passed and I decided that it was time to follow the Islam rules and divorce her and marry another wife.

It was during this time that I met my Christian friend. I shared with him what I was going through, and he invited me to attend a study they were having. To kill my boredom, I agreed.

When I found them reading some bible stories in my mother tongue, I enjoyed the stories so much that I forgot about my divorce and continued to attend the teachings. A few months later, I discovered that I needed a true Savior in my life and in my marriage.

I gave my life to Christ, went home, and started reading the books with my children. My wife would pretend not to pay attention to what I was reading, but I knew that she was listening. Everyday, we would read the stories together.

After reading about the love of God to His people even when they disobeyed, I told my wife that I still loved her even if she did not believe me.

For many months, I had not seen her smile, but this day, I saw it. She asked for forgiveness which I did wholeheartedly, and that same day, I told her that I am now a Christian.

I have never seen my wife this happy before. She gave her life to Christ too, and now we are a happy family, saved from divorce and saved from sin. I thank God for the lessons I have learned from the books. These books rescued my marriage."

Many lives are being rescued from darkness and the plans of the evil one through the chronological books.

42-June 8, 2023

From Uganda:

"I am [Name withheld]. I was born as a Muslim and married into a Muslim family. Watching my family members grow into hatred and jealousy as a family has been one challenging factor.

Many women always admire to be married into Islamic families, hoping there is peace, but this is not the genuine truth. Massive lies which are held here are unknown to many people outside of these families.

Being born in Islamic family, I was only allowed a little education, but most of my times my mother, being a devoted Muslim, would recite for me the Quran and sometimes force me to recite by force . . . with canes [beatings].

I would attend Madrasa or Quranic schools with Arabic teachings. Although we were in these classes with boys, girls were not allowed to mix or intermingle with the boys.

Fear befell me as they read in the Quran, Surat [Chapter] 19, as women are not allowed to touch the Quran. We are also not allowed to attend Ijumaa prayers when we have our periods, as we are unclean and Allah cannot answer our prayers.

In my family, my husband who is a truck driver, would treat me as a useless woman. In the Quran, men can marry 4 wives, but even as your right hand possesess. So my husband has what is termed as Nikkah kind of marriages. And when I spoke, he would threaten me with tawafa (divorce). This frustrated me so much.

Then, there came a burden to seek the truth as one day there was a crusade/debate between Islamic scholars (Sheikh and Imams) and Christians organized by the church here through chronological booklets.

In sharing, a young man whom I later came to know as Joseph Okello, shared on God's love and these are the words he said, "Whenever [an Israelite] sinned, an animal must die." This sank deep in my heart as I was so much interested in understanding. How many times have we slaughtered animals during the holy month of Ramadhan. It means that Satan has not been chained as the [Muslim] scholars would cry out.

Literally, all things that I had believed in were turning into lies to me. This team gave me the chronological booklets which I studied diligently at my shop as I feared my husband would find out.

My behavior started changing by itself. I saw a greater victory by a seed of woman. Loudly, I shouted, for women can be and are a part of these booklets.

When my husband later learned, I told myself not to leave these great teachings. I chose to embrace them no matter what challenge. There is no way. I can be clean or I can go back to watery mud. That is foolishness. Islam is real scum.

I bought my own Bible which I love dearly, but I only study it with the help of these booklets. My husband now has set me free to worship my God and all of my five children have joined me.

I pray my husband, too, will become a believer in Christ who died for us. 'I am the way, truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.'

Jesus, thank you for being a way unto me. Reveal yourself more. Now that I have all these booklets, I'll study more. I don't want to be left behind in this great campaign. Mariam Nawire Christine

43-June 13, 2023

This testimony is from Brother Lawrence in Uganda. He used to be a truck driver. One day, he was highjacked, and shot through the spine, immediately crippling him. Now, every day, he must be dragged outside the home to spend the day outside, and then dragged back into the home at night. Here is his testimony:

"He is the ever faithful God, and He blesses people lives differently. My family was totally paralyzed, and there was no one to speak to my heart a message of hope.

Being a Catholic, I only knew that the means to pray to God is to pass through Mary, and that martyrs were praying for us. This I questioned a lot, yet no truth did I find in these.

During the day, many times, my little daughter or my young niece open for me the chronological booklets as I read them. This has been my Bible. It has been my way of life. I have embraced these teachings, and I have the faith of heaven.

Many times, different people have come to convince me and my family to go to the shrine. Sometimes they have told me that I am cursed. But my answer has been found within the lines of the booklets.

The same way that Satan tempted Jesus, wanting Him to sin, he also tempts us daily in order for us to sin. Thanks be to God for Lessons 49 and 50 which taught me a lot concerning this.

I felt the Spirit ministering to me and immediately I realized I need this Redeemer who died for me. I believe in Him."

48-July 2, 2023

Felix Bright writes that the testimony by a Karamajong chief in Uganda gave us a humbling moment, and everyone couldn't stop crying as He kept on testifying:

"Brothers, there is no worse place in terms of cattle rustling than the Karamoja region and their brothers, the Turkana of Kenya. This has brought discrimination and many lives have been lost. My son was a victim and I had nothing else to do.

Personally, I have ordered for the mass killing of the thieves. Burning the thieves hasn't helped us. Cutting them into small pieces like firewood hasn't helped us. Imprisoning them is even not a problem to them.

When the government tries more force like offering to pay the people who want to be spies of such thieves,, this has even brought more stealing. Many children and family have been burned to warn others, but all this cannot stop them.

Sometime back in December last year, I got a letter requesting for a permission to hold a teaching by the name of chronological teaching which looked strange and foreign. At first, I didn't accept because I thought these are the very people who support stealing and even sponsor the thieves with weapons in the name of Bible mission work.

To confirm this, I made an agreement and these teachers were placed to sleep near a cattle house to ensure that if the cows were taken, they would be held responsible. Throughout their stay, nothing happened, and I said that we need to give them more time to know who they are.

Today, I am here to invite you, my sons, not only in the church but even in the prisons to share these booklets to the people. Maybe they'll change. I am accepting this message and I believe in Him whom you preach. Your God is

bringing sanity into our land. Thanks for coming again and thanks more to God for giving you a bold heart to love the Karamoja region...."

Before He could finish, he broke into a loud cry and uncontrollable one.

48-July 5, 2023

Bithian sent me this testimony from one of the parents:

"I have had a very difficult time with my daughter since when she did her [grade school] exams and graduated to join high school. She changed completely and thought she was now a grown up.

She became rude. She was never home and when asked she would answer rudely. Her father caned her one day and she disappeared from home, only to find her married to another old man as a third wife. We reported the matter to the police who helped us get her home. We took her to school again and we were so afraid that she would run away from school.

We thank God for what the school has done to our daughter when she came home this mid term week. Ooh, we have seen a new person!

Our girl is back to herself. She has found a meaning in her life. She told us that she has given her life to Christ after knowing the truth that she was a sinner and she needed a Savior!

She showed us copy of some books that she has been reading while in school about God and that she discovered that she was in the wrong tribe, the tribe of Satan and his demons—the tribe that rude and proud people belong to, and so she decided to join God's tribe, tribe of the humble—the tribe of good people, a tribe where children obey their parents, and she is now a child of God.

My daughter knelt down and asked for forgiveness from me and her father. We were amazed and we hugged and cried too–tears of joy–for she was lost and now she is back home.

I came to school to see the teacher and share the joy and also thank them for the books that my daughter is reading. They told me a girl called Bithian is the one who gave them the books and she is teaching them the Bible stories. I pray for her

and the one who wrote the book. Thank you for redeeming my girl. God bless you." Mama Immaculate

50-July 5, 2023

Bithian sent me this testimony from one of the teachers:

"God is never late or early. He is always on time. These lessons came to our school at the right time, the time we were struggling to bring the girls back to life.

Wih technology every week,we would suspend a girl from school. Bad behavior, pornography, and sometimes drugs would be found in the dormitory. Academically, their school grades were sliding low.

We were so concerned about the girls until God brought Bithian to our school. with so simple lessons that we thought were too basic. She has done magic to our girls. We are at peace now with the students, and we are rising our grades again.

We have received testimonies from parents, too, of the change in their daughters. This has pushed me also to study the lessons and, am learning a lot too. What I thought was too basic is the truth from the Bible.

The books are so well arranged that you wish to continue reading the whole book. I was among those who believed there was no salvation, but now! A girl with scars on her face has shown me the light, too.

I read the books with my family too as I desire to share the truth with them. I am planning to give my wife a surprise gift of announcing to her that I have given my life to Christ too! It is still a secret."

Wycliffe finished by saying:

"Reading these testimonies gives me the strength to keep teaching and going around Kenya to let the people know the truth. How many are out their waiting for these booklets?

51-August 12, 2023

From Witchcraft to Christ follower:

I am Sawias Shares. I am 58 years of age, a widow with 5 children. I was in a family which knew nothing concerning the love of God.

The god whom we worshipped demanded blood sacrifice. In our clan, the family of my father were the custodian of the deity. We worshipped them and even offered sacrifices to them.

I remember I was initiated into witch craft one year before my father's demise as I was the only child. I automatically became the heir.

I got married, made a home for the deity, and I would offer food to them though they didn't eat. Being a witch doctor was my pride.

One day, before my husband went to war in the Nuba mountains, I made for him a special charm. When he died there, I started doubting the powers of our deities. The more I tried, the more I faced challenges.

One morning, a sheik came to me. He did his incantation to scare away the evil. This, too, did not work.

Last year, my young sons came with a teaching and as I was on the run for my life, I decided to only listen. These booklets captivated me and I carried some back to the Nuba mountains for my family. We had the peace of God in us as we read the booklets, even though they needed to be interpreted, as I don't have any English.

When the second teaching came to me in Juba, I realized that these teachings were very true. I love them. On Sunday, I was part of those who were baptized in water as a sign of repentance. I pray that my family too would be baptized just as I was.

I have found a peace that I cannot describe. I have no more fear of serving the gods of the land. Earlier this year, I burned the house in which I had sacrificed to the demons.

Thanks for sharing these booklets, we want to learn more from them.

52-August 16, 2023

I am Makua Batil Tumana of the Koalib tribe of the Nubians. For all of my life, all that I have known has been witchcraft although I am a Muslim by religion.

Being a witch doctor has caused me to commit a lot of sins like killing, damaging families, intimidation, and much more. I remember that women would come to me, and I would lie to them and even rape them in order to satisfy myself.

On Saturday, I was up on the mountain needing to make a choice as I had been hearing strange voices telling me to repent. I heard people praying, and for the first time, the whole mountain was covered by light. I heard a voice speaking to me to repent.

I am so feared that when people see me they would run away, thinking I would kill them instantly. I didn't know that it was the devil using me.

Before I knew it, I was powerless and paralyzed on the ground while people were praying. While I was on the ground, I had a picture in a dream of a man telling me to repent and be baptized. I knew this was to be a very hard task and I wasn't ready for it.

On Sunday, I started walking, asking about the people who were praying on the mountain. When I reached them, everyone started to run away, but I told them not to run because I wanted to talk to them about something very important concerning my life.

The people were talking about baptism--the very word that I had heard in the dream. They also said that if I would repent, Jesus Christ will forgive me of my witchcraft, rape, and killing, among many other sins.

At this point, I broke into tears because of what I had done. "You mean Jesus can forgive me of all of this? You mean Jesus can forgive me for being a witch? You mean Jesus can forgive me for killing his people? You mean Jesus can forgive me of all of my sins?"

When I was reassured of this, I told everyone that nothing could stop me from believing in Jesus and being baptized.

A few people said that I could not be baptized because I did not have clothes to change, but I told them, "If I have been rained on at the top of this mountain for more than five hours while serving demons and idols, a short time is nothing. I am ready and nothing will stop me, for I want to repent and be forgiven of my sins. I receive Jesus as my Lord and Savior." At this point, everyone broke into tears.

The rest is from Felix, the evangelist working in South Sudan: "We used a donkey to carry water which we poured into a hole that we had dug specifically for baptism. Having confessed Jesus, Brother Makua was then baptized.

"Praise the Lord that you have been part of the team not only in sending financially to print these booklets, but also in prayer just like Hannah in the Bible. Thank you so much for being part of what God is doing. Keep praying for boldness and peace in our hearts as we share the gospel with the unreached. We love you so much and we remain humbled to minister together with the chronological biblical study."

53-August 25, 2023

Pastor James Mutembei wrote from Maua Meru:

When we reached the forest, we found some had already arrived there, and they were slashing the grass and preparing the place where we were to sit and listen to the word of God. To me, I saw passionate people who are in need of a Saviur and nothing would stop them from finding one if there was a chance.

Please keep on praying for these new believers for the Lord to strengthen them and that they would become an army to spread the word of God.

Many folks came to the Lord and they said that they believe in this teaching. "It is true! It is true!"

From a Maasai elder:

"Listening to God is one of the things I have learnt from these books. God wants us to listen to Him. I now know that God speaks to us and we must listen to him.

I have been a big headed man. I did what I wanted and no one could stop me. I remember fighting in the market and being arrested and spending weeks in the cells just for not listening to my wife who had told me to stop. I chose my ways just like Lot who didn't listen to God and ended up in a bad place full of evil.

I want to obey and listen to God just like Abraham. The books are teaching me how to obey God. God created us. Cows can not save us. Only God can. All my animals died when we had the drought. They left me, but God has not left me, He still teaches me."

57-September 21, 2023

"I am Hussein, a Form Three student at Renewal school in Yida. On Monday when I heard the news about the teachings to be taught in our school through the chronological booklets, I was eager to learn.

The only challenge is I am a Muslim, and in our family, while growing up, my family taught me one important lesson—life is war and we have to fight physically. If one is a Christian, he must be killed or be fought until he believes in Allah (Jihad).

If a woman disrespected the husband, she must either be divorced, beaten or be denied conjugal rights. This I personally saw my brother doing, and that has been making me so worried, beating my own wife.

In these lessons I am learning about the love for the enemy. We are God's enemy, but He first he loved us. Because of Adam, the ground was cursed, and an animal was slaughtered [so that Adam could be clothed]. This really is not true in Islam which allows the death of infidels and non-believers. I am learning a lot, but yet I want to know the truth and follow it when I am ready."

Felix writes: "Please pray for Hussein, that the Lord would touch him more and bring him to Christ. Amen."

58-September 23, 2023

From Felix:

"Yesterday while we were continuing to share, Hussein came in front and boldly believed the Lordship of the Lord Jesus Christ.

He said that Jesus has been speaking with Him through dreams, but that He has never ever understood the real meaning. As we were sharing, he said this:

'I remembered what war has done to our land, that our people are dying of hunger, that they are so thirsty yet no water to drink, and that they are killing each other.

There is no greater joy than to find there is a man who died for me. He died so that I can live—just as an animal died so that Adam and Eve could live. As for my prophet [Mohamed], he died and has never came back to life. I have no hope in Him. I want to follow my Savior. It is only Jesus who can save me—no one else.'

In yesterday's gathering, many folks accepted the lordship of Christ over their lives at Renewal high school. We are going to have time for discipleship every Sunday with them, just as we were having it in Juba."

59-September 25, 2023

Gisma Tutu is a student of Renewal high school. Here is her testimony:

"I was born in the Nuba mountains of Sudan. I came to the Yida refugee camp in 2015 at the peak of war which was so severe in the Nuba mountains. I lost my mother in the war which has so challenged me in the brain and this has led to many more challenges.

I have always wanted revenge for what happened to me, wanting to kill, and this has almost called me into witch craft. I did not know that one day I would have someone who would share with me a lovely message from a lovely book about a lovely God.

My heart is full of tears of sorrow by seeing my mother dead, by seeing my brothers have become war addicts, and by smoking (not clear here).

Today, I have chosen to change my ways. I want to walk with Jesus. I am beginning a new journey with my Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

Please pray with me. I am among the students who brought charms to be burnt. I feel a peace that I have never felt before. I am feeling fresh inside and the rottenness has gone.

I am happy to be called a child of God, and I am praying that the Lord will help me to forgive all those who hurt me so much by taking my price, my beloved mother in my presence." Gisma Tutu.

60-September 26, 2023

Nayere from Burundi said, "Many times I have tried to understand sin because I am told not to sin. So what is sin and where did it start? This have been my question and now I know. Sin is living against the standards of God. No wonder we are all sinners. These books have made it clear to me that from creation, God wants us to worship him and to do His will. Only God is good and all people are bad. The chronological booklets have this all."

61-September 26, 2023

Pastor Nduwamungu from Burundi is happy that he is learning both the word of God and Swahili too. "I have the full joy of my life now that am learning God's Word as I learn how to read Swahili too. This has made it easy for my evangelism class. My class had only 12 students but now I have 50. As many come, I believe they will hear the truth from the books too. I hope our Bishop will send us more books soon."

62-September 26, 2023

From Pastor Emabale in Rwanda: "I wish we had these books before [the genocide] happened. I am sure there would have been no tribal wars. People perished because they lacked knowledge. The knowledge has come to us now. The truth is in these books. When we know God, we know the truth. God has revealed himself in His Word, and it is true—the Word is God himself. These

lessons help us discover this truth. Genocide happened because there was no truth. People were in darkness."

63-October 6, 2023

From the president of the ADC, one of the largest denominations in eastern Africa:

"God is always doing a new thing with an aim of making us His friends always. Teaching the chronological lessons has made me know more about the Lord I serve. I have had more joy just by teaching simple truths with simple booklets. Giving these booklets to someone makes me feel like giving birth to a new person or giving new life to a dead body. 64-October 11, 2023

"My name is Vestinah Vazamungabo. I am alone in the world as I lost all of my family in the genocide. For years I have struggled, asking myself why God spared my life. I remember very well that the night before it happened, our parents gathered all of us together and asked us to give our lives to Jesus as this would be the only way we would have peace in our lives. That same night, the killings began in the neighboring village.

I never knew if my parents knew what was going to happen as our village was attacked the next day. Everyone in my family who was home was killed. The only reason I survived is because I was in school. I ran off from school with my friends. We spent days and days running and running, not even knowing where we were running to, until we found ourselves in Burundi where we were taken to a refugee camp.

Living in the refugee camp, the words of my parents have never left me. For all this time, I have been struggling to understand, "Who is this Jesus whom my father

spoke of"?

A year ago, my friend invited me to attend a training in Kenya. I accepted because the church was paying for us. In Kenya, I was only excited because this was my first time to get out of the refugee camp. What I didn't know was that this trip would be the answer to all of my prayers.

In the training, we were taught of God's grace upon us sinners and His love for us. The people who love Him are of His tribe and those who hate him are of Satan's tribe. I thought of the people who killed my family and wondered where they would belong.

What has filled me with joy is that I have discovered who this Jesus is! He is the one who died for me so that I may live. When people disobeyed God, Jesus took the blame. This I discovered from a set of books that I received in our training, that is, the chronological lessons. I now have a treasure for I now have my very own booklets.

I now know Abrahan, Lot, Moses, and many others for I was taught about them. I now love Jesus because He is my life. He is also my strength and the way to my eternal joy.

I want to live a life that fits in the standard of God. I want to teach my people these lessons. I know that there are more like me who are seeking for the truth. I want to give them these books because they are self taught. No need to follow false prophets.

Whenever I feel stressed, I read the books and feel happy. These books have changed me and my views about life.

I have forgiven those who killed my family. I believe that I will one day meet Jesus and tell him how He has made me happy.

I am praying for whoever wrote these booklets that God will give them more light about His word and then write more books."

65-November 2, 2023

"I thank God for these teachings. They have taught me how to forgive.

I got married to a lovely woman whom I didn't know she was married before. We lived together for one year without my knowledge of her previous marriage. She got pregnant with our first born child and hell broke loose for me.

One day, I came home and found three men standing in my compound. I greeted them and asked them why they were here. They told me that they had just escorted their brother here, that he is inside, and that I can go talk to him.

I hurried into the house, only to find my wife in a corner and a body of a man lying dead in my living room with blood all over the floor. I asked my wife what happened, and she said that the man had come to take her back as he was her husband.

When she refused, the man grabbed her hand, but she pushed him, and he fell on the table that broke and a piece of wood pierced his head. This shocked me, but because of the love I had for her and the unborn child, I took the responsibility when the police came.

I was jailed for ten years for murder. After the ten years, I came home only to find my wife had married another man for she couldn't wait for me. This made me mad, for I was jailed for something I didn't do, carrying someone else's sin, and yet, she still got married and left me.

My anger grew every day. I thought about it daily until I came to the church and listened to some stories that our pastor was sharing with us. The Israelites kept disobeying God, yet God loved them. God sent his Son to take our sins, but we are the ones who should have been crucified. He did it for us, yet on the cross, Jesus still prayed for them even while He was still hanging on the cross.

This struck me and I felt that I needed to be like Jesus. Yes, I was jailed for love just like Jesus who died on the cross because he loved us. I gave my life to Jesus and asked Him to teach me how to forgive. Indeed he taught me how.

I visited my child where they lived and forgave my wife and got reunited with my loving daughter. The pain went away. The hatred I had for women went away.

Jesus gave me another wife, and now, I am living happily with my daughter and her new mother.

This happened because of the teachings the pastor taught us from the 68 books he came with. I am waiting to get my copy so I can share with the others who are still in pain like I was. I call them the forgiveness manuals! I am Vincent."

66-November 2, 2023

"As a Rwandan, it is very easy for me to relate with the two tribes, that is, the tribe of God and the tribe of Satan. In Rwanda, we have the Tutsis and Hutus who have all lived together like brothers.

I loved the story of Joseph. They all lived together as brothers until when Satan took over Joseph's brothers and they decided to kill their own. The same happened in Rwanda. Satan took over, brothers hated each other, and brothers killed each other.

I have had the same hatred too. I hated the Hutus so much because I believe they killed my two brothers. From the chronological booklets, Cain killed his brother Abel because of Satan who wanted more people to disobey God. I was heading to that point of disobeying God.

I used to attend church, but I didn't have a personal relationship with God. Just like Cain, I would give my offerings with hate in my heart. After this training, I now know where my hate is coming from. I now know it is Satan who wants to take me away from God. I won't allow him.

I have been planning to take revenge for my brothers' death, but now I believe God loves me. This is why he sent you. God saw what Cain did. God saw what Joseph's brothers did. I believe he also saw what happened in Rwanda. I am here to give my hate to Jesus and renounce my pains. I want to remain in the tribe of God and be a son of God, not Satan." Haberimana Salim

67-November 7, 2023

Ahmdan Ibrahims from the Dalokal tribe in Nuba Mountains, South Sudan.

"Sometimes, being a father, we learn many things through mistakes.

I was once married and with my wife, we had three kids. I later traveled to Khartoum and when I came back to Nuba mountain, I started abusing my wife.

Being a Muslim, it is not a crime to beat your wife until they obey, and I would gladly use that scripture to beat my wife vigorously. Today, I regret over the things that I did. My wife separated from me before the war began in the Nuba Mountains, and took our kids away with her since I was so much of a drunk. I could not take care of the children nor even myself.

I started living a reckless life of drinking, using witchcraft, fighting, and all of this would break me when I didn't even know that they're breaking me.

When the war began, I came in to South Sudan as a refugee, and this is where I started realizing the importance of freedom. I fell sick in the Yida refugee camp, and more sickness came as the days passed by Going to the hospital, I was told that I had a problem in my chest. Weeks later, I developed a problem with breathing and later on in my bones.

I was so low that I went into witchcraft. I cut myself and placed charms on the wounds. I also had a charm around my waist from one of the Muslim sheiks, but none of these helped me.

I thank Jesus today for I have found God who healed me. I no longer feel pain in my chest, and my breathing has improved since I said "Yes" to Jesus Christ. My bones also are no longer weak, for I am growing strong again.

Today, I am a believer in Jesus Christ. I am happy that I was baptized, and every Sunday, I attend for more teaching. My appetite for alcohol is gone. I am no longer going to the mosque or even witchcraft. I threw the charms away.

I had found total freedom in Jesus Christ. I want to be a written testimony, a book that every Muslim will know about.

Hallelujah. I pray that God will bring me more joy, that I would meet my kids, and ask for forgiveness for having been a bad father. Amen.

Testimony from the printer in Nairobi, Kenya:

"We have been in the business of printing for several years now and you are one of our valued customers. Not because of the money you pay but the effect of what we are printing. Ever since you gave us permission to use the books in our morning devotions, I have seen a great spiritual growth with my staff. There is more harmony and friendship among the staff.

Kimanzi was alcoholic. He would come drunk on duty, but he has changed a lot. Not just him but more of the staff have changed. I believe some have given their lives to Christ, but haven't announced it yet. We no longer push them to work. They all work with minimal supervision and the production has also increased. We read a lesson each day and then pray together. I have assigned each one a lesson to read, and all must attend the prayer time.

This books are magical, simple and to the point. It goes straight to what we need to know. Am reading the lessons to my kids too, now that the schools are closed and they are home.

Once again, thank you for trusting us to serve you and also sharing this wisdom with us."

When we asked about the price he is charging us to print, this is what he said:

"We will keep the same price we charge even if the price of paper and ink has gone up. Currently we are meeting the exact printing cost and we are happy to continue because we have more customers who have come in and we can get more profit from them as we take part in this noble cause of sharing the Good news. God bless you."

69-November 8, 2023

"I am Sarah from the Shatt tribe in the Nuba Mountains.

Fighting is one of the activities that we, as a community, love. Growing up, I would see people fighting not just for land or food or wives, but we literally fought for everything.

Being married, I developed the culture of fighting even in the family. I would fight my husband so badly that he feared me. We are reknown women of war, and this brought me to the state I am today. My husband couldn't put up with me anymore and we separated.

When war broke out, I came from Kaduguli to Yida, South Sudan, as a refugee, and started a life of staying with my kids, Iklas, Ikram, and Thu. Alone, I have been raising them up, but believing in war and fighting. Anything that I wanted, I would fight for it forcefully whether with a knife or any other means as long as it would be mine.

Through the teachings I have been receiving, I said that I want this Jesus because I understood how war has broke up my family. Now that I am a believer of Jesus Christ, I no longer have the appetite of war. Fighting with people is no longer a part of me. I am no longer interested in fighting and am glad I am a changed person."

70-November 8, 2023

"Baptism doesn't save us. It is, however, a symbol that we are dying and are ressurecting with Jesus. It is an act of obedience to Jesus Christ through Great commission. In the Yida Refugee camp, this is one of the four ordinances misinterpreted and neglected by the religious leaders putting aside prayer, the Holy Spirit, and Holy Communion.

The evangelical church in Block Eleven which is the Daloka people group knew little of the Lord Jesus Christ. We have been sharing these teachings, and we thank God that He is teaching His truth through us, and that we are not speaking in our own flesh.

The last week of October on a Sunday, we were able to baptize many people. After the baptism, many people shared a testimony of what the Lord Jesus Christ has done in their lives

Yaba said, "I had placed somebody in my heart and made a vow to never forgive him after what he did to me. Now I feel myself so light. I am seeing no more need to hurt him. I want to meet him and tell him that I have forgiven him."

Gismo Tutu says, "For a long time, I always thought that baptism was not a

necessary thing. Others have scared us, telling us that if we are baptized, we shall go back to our old life of evil. Today, I am saying that now that I am baptized, my bad dreams are gone, and I am able to sleep as well as a little child."

"When we see the Gospel as a Good News from God and not a white man's message, this becomes the beginning of every means to reach out to God. I thought that this was a white man's message to confuse black people, but now I know that it a message from God." From TR at Napoleon Renewal High School.

71-November 8, 2023

Before conversion, Yusuf was a Muslim man as well as both of his parents. One day, the Lord visited the grandfather of Yusuf (who was an Imam), and his life never remained the same.

The Muslim leaders in Khartoum tried to convince Yusuf's grandfather (his name was Yunus) to recount, and when he refused, they burned him at the stake. Before Yunus was burned to death, he removed his bangle and gave it as a blessing to Yusuf telling him to always remember that he is an icon or reflector of peace in their tribe.

Upon the death of Yunus, Yusuf was heartbroken and decided to learn the truth. One day, he said "yes" to the Lord. In spite of the many challenges of witchcraft, sorcery, murder, rape, and abduction, Yusuf has remained steadfast in His duty of praying for His people.

Just like Yusuf, let us take the burden of reaching and praying for communities in the Nuba mountains. Lord, we pray that many will know you through the testimony of Yusuf in Jesus' mighty name. Amen.

72-November 8, 2023

Abdu Salim, from Renewal High School, is one of the many converts who has believed in the Lord Jesus Christ, a humbled man who wants to know the Lord.

Since knowing the truth about the Lord Jesus Christ, he has never left the teachings of the Lord Jesus, indicating a humbled heart who is ready to learn and to teach others.

Testimony of Thuku Tia from the Shatt tribe who has been forced to live a life of bitterness and unforgiveness due to what happened to him. He is a 7th Class pupil at Omolo Primary School in Yida, and has faced different challenges. This was due to the civil war in the Nuba mountains.

"I can't remember everything as I was young, but one day while we were in the Nuba mountains in our school, war broke out. I saw a plane flying from a far distance, and a voice spoke to me, that I was to run into a fox hole (there are hideouts which are dug all over the Nuba mountain so that when war erupts, one can find safety).

Before I could enter inside (I really don't understand what took place), I felt a sharp pain in my right hand and coldness. Finding my self inside a fox hole, I was bleeding profusely. I tried to stop the blood, but fainted. What I can remember after many days were wounds and half an arm missing from my body.

Learning to work with one hand with another lame has not been an easy task for me for I was not born like that. When I understood that it was a civil war

involving Arabs, I have had a deep hatred for Arabs while fearing planes.

My hand got healed and I had to learn to work without an arm, but one thing surely never got healed—my heart—a scar that could take seasons and seasons to heal. I dropped out of school and when I came to the refugee camp, there was one thing in me—revenge.

After a series of sharing these booklets, I have understood what it means to forgive my enemies. I want to go to heaven even if I am missing one hand. I have forgiven my enemies and I am walking a new journey.

Thanks to Bright Felix for being a tool to share these teachings."

74-November 17, 2023

This is from Felix working in South Sudan. A testimony from a former Muslim:

"In my life," says [name withheld], "I have never received this kind of a message of a loving God, in a loving manner, in a loving way.

I have always wanted to know God more. Being a Muslim is like being chained, and we need the truth to be taught, learnt, and to be made known to the Muslim world.

Today, it is a great privilege to hear of the Good News about God and His Son, although I didn't believe this at first, being taught differently by the sheiks (Muslim teachers). I have lived in lies and hated the truth. I have fought and rejected the truth.

But when this Son of God appeared to me in a dream with bleeding hands, asking me why am I beating myself on the rock and denying Him, I wept and I said that I needed to be forgiven. What's more amazing is that this very dream appeared to my wife and to one of my sons.

We needed this message and we have taken it in. We are Christians from now on. Only please do not expose us because we are with Muslims all the time. Please don't take any of our photos but let someone come to share with us the Good Message to help us to grow and to soon be ready to face the world."

Not to be openly shared: Abdul Karims and his family live near the mosque. He has a wife, two brothers, and four children.

75-December 1, 2023

Sister Amira has been a great tool being used by the Lord to preach to different souls, and through her, her entire household who were previously non-believers are now believing.

Her husband said this: "I have learnt from my wife through the stories in the booklets of the importance of believing in God. I am no longer a Muslim. My God doesn't want me to kill for him. He died for me and I want this good God." Sadik, Amira's husband.

76-December 1, 2023

Brother Khakis Tutu shares with us how the devil damaged his life, but thanks to God who has brought salvation, and made it possible.

"Having done all things in the religion of Islam, nothing could save me. I was so addicted to sin that one day I ran naked from my farm. Everybody who looked at me laughed. Slowly but surely I was running mad.

When my sisters shared with me the booklets, all that I could say was that one day God could bring it to pass. I am here because God has saved me from the power of sin, Satan, and death. Thanks for sharing Jesus with us."

77-December 13, 2023

From PAG Name Withheld (Kenya?):

"God blessed me with only one child, a girl who I loved so much. My husband and I did all we could to see her through the school until she got married and had a nice paying job with the government. To this day, I remember how we struggled with schooling her and now she is gone. We cannot enjoy the fruits of our labor, and I got envious. The devil filled me with hatred for her husband as I thought he was the one who took her from us. I wanted my daughter back—not because of my love for her, but for her wealth.

Because of this, I went to a witch doctor who gave me a charm to kill her husband. I was to put it in his food which I did. Unfortunately her husband came late and my daughter ate the food and died. I killed my daughter!

I have lived in this pain for years until I got these booklets that transformed me. I haven't confessed this to anyone, but I am telling you as I ask God for forgiveness. From the books I have learned that there are only two tribes—the bad and the good, the people of God and the people of Satan. I have to choose where to belong. I don't want to go to hell.

Just as God forgave the Israelites, I begged Him to forgive me too. I trust in the Savior whom God sent to save us from sin. I confessed to Him my sins and am asking for courage on how to face my husband. These books have taught me the freedom we have in Christ. These books have taught me the true love of God. These books have taught me forgiveness. I am free because I have given my life to Jesus. I thank God for sending these books to me."

78-December 15, 2023

From Bithian in Kapsobet, Kenya:

My name is Francis Livuga, a teacher at St Mary's Yala girls. I am a proud teacher today because of the chronological lessons. At first, I despised the lessons, thinking they were too basic, but now I confess there is no basic in the word of God. Every word of God is true and it is God Himself.

Bithian began to teach in our school late last year. Our school was rated among the undisciplined schools in the county. Every term we lost students who transferred to other schools. The opposite has happened. We now have lots of applications to join our school as there is a great change with the students.

Bithian has helped bring sanity back through the lessons. Last term, a group of girls brought to the office all their sex toys that they had brought to school without our knowledge. Seeing these girls kneeling and begging for forgiveness from the teachers opened my eyes too. I also cried because we had never seen such things before and we never knew what our girls were doing.

We all held our hands together and prayed as Bithian led the girls to Christ. As a teacher, I did the same. I gave my life to Christ the same day too. The atmosphere

at the school is now family life. During our parents-teachers meeting, all the parents testified of the changes in their girls and thanked the Lord for the new program that we began in school. We are so proud of Bithian and we thank God for using the lessons to help our girls and me to see the light.

79-December 15, 2023

I am Beatrice, a student in Kapsobet, and my life was hell. When I joined the school in Form One, I joined a group of girls who I thought were good girls. They always had money, and could buy anything they wanted. They promised to teach me the business that they do so that I could earn my own money.

When the schools closed for the holiday, we met and they took me to a hotel where they forced me to have sex with a man old enough to be my father. He gave me money after which I was happy, but hurt in my heart. We did this the whole holiday and when we came back to school, I had money too.

We sneaked out of school several times to record ponographic videos and we bought sex toys that we used to record videos. I am so ashamed of what we did. The worst thing is that I got pregnant and I had to abort the baby. This damaged my uterus and I will never have a child.

I am so ashamed of myself, but have hope after the lessons that I have been learning through the booklets. I belonged to the wrong tribe of murderers. I belonged to the devil's tribe, but now I gave my life to Christ after learning that He is the only one who can save me.

I thank God for sending us a Savior who can carry all of our filth and give us hope. I have surrendered all to Christ and I believe in Him to forgive and to save me. The lessons are so simple and easy to understand. I am now a proud daughter of God.

Sharing one microphone was such an amazing moment, and there is no greater joy than seeing many crying out unto the Lord as He alone can save us.

Pastor William had to share this testimony with us:

"My name is Geoffrey Luvaha and I am a proud listener of Vuuka Fm Radio. I do not go to church because the pastors only preach about money and their own personal issues. From Pastor Moffat:

"We have had a lot of rain in eastern Kenya. Since I could not get back home because of the rains, I decided to visit a village where I have taught before.

I entered the village and I was met by a Muslim guy who was so happy to meet me. I couldn't remember him, but he greeted me with joy and invited me to his house. When I was in his home, I listened to him as he told me what had happened. Here is his story:"

"I was a Muslim, and I have been practicing sorcery. I was lying to people that I could heal their sicknesses and anything else. All I needed was their money.

One day, I came home and my wife gave me a booklet to read in Borana, for she is

a Borana. I hated Christians as this is what I was taught at the Madrassa (Muslim school). I asked her what the book was about, but she told me to just read it.

I have read all the lessons. The last time Pastor Moffatt was teaching here, I came to the church, but nobody recognized me. I wanted to know who gave the books to my wife. The books have spoken to me.

When the rains came, I gave God a test. All the years that it has been raining, we had to move to other places. This time, I asked the God of these booklets to prove to me that He is my Savior and to save us from moving. I promised Him that if He would save me, I would give my life to Him.

As I told the pastor, we are still here. Yes, some houses have been swept away by the floods, but mine still stands. This is proof that the Savior lives. So, I was waiting for the pastor to lead me to Him. I asked God to send the pastor to me, and now the pastor is here.

I called together my wife and my children. I said, 'Please, from today, my family and I, we surrender to the Savior.'"

Pastor Moffatt concludes by saying this: "I prayed for them with tears of joy in my eyes. Indeed, our Lord is ALIVE! The entire family of seven children, husband, and wife are now in the Lord's family. Glory to God!"

From Wycliffe:

THE RADIO PROGRAM. God has given us an opportunity to teach chronological lessons through the radio every Sunday from 8:00 am to 9:00 am with over a million listeners. This is the first program to be aired in a Kenyan radio. We are humbled with messages that encourage us to keep teaching, as lives are being transformed through the truths we share.

MAASAI: The Maa community, as they are often referred to, are in Kenya and Tanzania. We have printed and translated thirty lessons (1-30), and the booklets are already in the bush with the people. We are continuing with the translation of lessons 31-42 into Maasai. After sharing the lessons in a church, one of the village chiefs has requested that the lessons be shared during his weekly government meeting with the village. This will be done in the open field at the

village square where everybody must attend. We are trusting God for the harvest.

BORANA: Pastor Moffat is teaching the Borana and the Somali in the northeastern side of Kenya to the border with Somalia. They are recovering from floods that affected most families. Most recently, an entire Muslim family of nine members gave their lives to Christ. This was in Gabra after teaching the booklets and understanding the truths of God.

PAG DENOMINATION: The PAG is among the larger denominations in Kenya. They have gone through all of the initial 68 lessons and are now teaching the chronological lessons in Acts. This is the church that has owned the lessons and has been paying half the price of printing the books. We just printed 4,000 copies of Acts to be distributed to 4,000 pastors at their 4,000 churches who will in turn make copies for their congregations. We estimate an average of 400,000 copies of Acts lessons will be distributed. With this, more people will know the truth.

ADC DENOMINATION: With churches in all the five East African Countries, ADC has embraced the lessons. We have launched the lessons in Rwanda and Burundi. During our training in Rwanda, one of the pastors said, "This is an eye opener. If we had this teaching earlier. we wouldn't have killed each other during the genocide. But now we are sure it will never happen again as we now have the light."

KUZA DADA INITIATIVE: This is spearheaded by Bithian in western Kenya whose aim is to reach out to teenage girls in high schools with the truths through the lessons. That which started with five girls is now in seven schools with over 2,000 students studying the lessons every week. Last year, the teaching ended with lesson 30 and next week, the schools will open and be ready to continue, starting with lesson 31. One of the teachers said this, "When I saw my students cry as they gave their lives to Christ after the lessons, I felt deep inside me to be among the right tribe and I was not ashamed to kneel before my students as I also gave my life to Jesus."

SOUTH SUDAN: Our brother Felix has been in South Sudan reaching out to refugees. He has been sharing with us how the Lord is using the booklets to touch lives. Two witch doctors have surrendered their lives to Christ after going through the lessons. So far, we have sent to them booklets in Arabic, Nuer (South Sudan), and English. We are trusting God for more this year.

These are but just insights of what is happening in East Africa. Our prayer is to have more booklets. Where man cannot go, these booklets will.
